

Don't Wait! Prescription Paper Will Soon Be Required By Law

New Legislation

According to legislation signed by President Bush in May, Medicaid outpatient drugs will only be reimbursable if prescriptions are written on tamper-resistant pads. The law is supposed to prevent illegally-obtained drugs by enforcing the use of tamper-resistant "scripts." The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services has proposed that this program be implemented by Oct 1, 2007!

Artificial Watermark clearly reading "Prescription Security" is printed in white opaque ink on backside of paper.

Coin Reactive Ink displays tampering with a simple scratch of a coin.

Toner Grip creates a more secure bond when laser print is applied to paper. Alteration is quickly identifiable because fibers embedded within the paper are destroyed on contact.

Chemically Reactive Paper prevents attempts to use chemical solvents to dissolve print due to an obvious discoloration of the paper.

Invisible Fluorescent Fibers are woven into the paper and will appear under a black light.
